BIKE THE GOING-TO-THE-SUN-ROAD

Bike or walk to Logan Pass before the full length of the Going-To-The-Sun-Road is open to vehicle traffic. Optimal dates are mid-May to mid-June. Visit the parks [Road Status page](#) or call the Apgar Visitor Center at (406) 888-7800 for updates on accessibility. VEHICLE RESERVATION 2023

In addition to your National Park Annual Pass, Glacier National Park has a vehicle reservation four areas of the park. Reservations are required for the west entrance to the Going-to-the-Sun Road and the North Fork between May 26 and September 10, 2023. Two Medicine, Many Glacier and the east entrance to the Going-to-the-Sun Road require reservations between July 1 and September 10, 2023.
