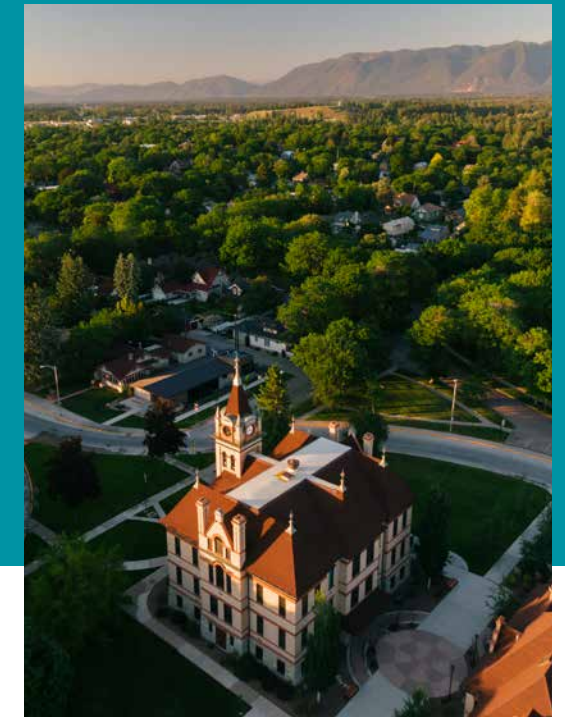

## GETTING HERE

Kalispell's Glacier Park International Airport (FCA) is served by Alaska, Allegiant, American, Delta, Sun Country and United, which fly to major cities nationwide with seasonal and year-round flights. Check [ [iflyglacier.com](http://iflyglacier.com) ] for the current flight schedule.

## GETTING AROUND

### Rental cars

Turo and most major rental car brands are located at—or close to—the airport.

### Shared transportation

Uber, Lyft and private taxi services are available. Some hotels offer airport shuttles.

### Public transportation

The Mountain Climber public transit system runs within Kalispell and surrounding towns. It does not offer service to the airport.

# TRAVEL TIPS

- 1 It's easier to get here than you may think: Kalispell's Glacier Park Intl Airport has direct flights from 16 major U.S. cities (some seasonal).
- 2 Plan a road trip with Kalispell as a home base to soak in wide open spaces and fresh mountain air.
- 3 Book your rental car and hotel early if you visit during the summer season.
- 4 We don't want to love Glacier National Park to death so learn all there is to do outside the Park.
- 5 Learn about GNP ticketing and reservation programs for summer 2026.
- 6 During July 2026 the airport's runways will be closed Monday evening through Friday morning to allow for a major rehabilitation project. What does that mean? Book your trip as early as possible, consider visiting during a different month, or fly to neighboring Missoula and enjoy the scenery and stops along the way to Kalispell. # SMALL TOWN CHARM, BIG MONTANA WELCOME

Downtown Kalispell's Main Street mixes historic character with modern shops, eateries and gathering spots, all wrapped in a welcoming mountain-town vibe. Stroll the sidewalks, grab a bite before heading out on your next adventure, or relax after a day outdoors and enjoy a taste of Montana living.

## HISTORICAL SNAPSHOT

**K**alispell, Montana, was established as a railroad town in 1891 by Charles Conrad for the Great Northern Railway and became the county seat by 1893. Early Kalispell, like other western towns, mixed vice and commerce and Main Street was considered the roughest in the Pacific Northwest until around 1927.

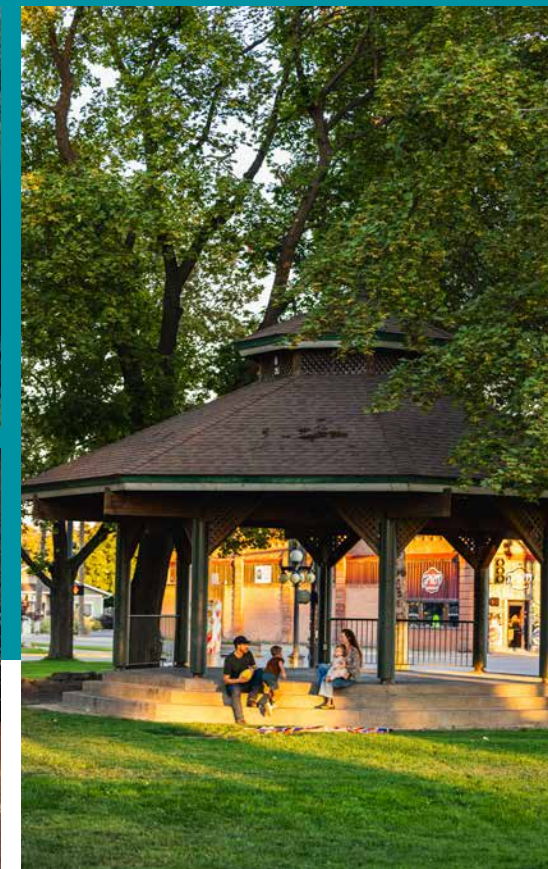
The corner of Main Street and 1st Street West is anchored by two of Kalispell's most iconic historic buildings. The Kalispell Grand Hotel has welcomed guests since 1911, when rooms cost just \$2 a night and featured luxuries like running water and locking doors. Notable guests included Frank Bird Linderman, Charlie Russell and Irvin S. Cobb. Today, the Grand remains a welcoming landmark, its Main Street windows offering a glimpse into the restored lobby and friendly hospitality inside.

On the adjacent corner stands Western Outdoor, housed in a building constructed in 1896 as McIntosh Hardware, which also included a gentlemen's clothing store and Opera House. The upstairs venue once accommodated 1,000 patrons and hosted dances, theater performances and roller skating before a 1935 fire ended its run. Today, the street-level store carries a wide variety of goods and for more than 45 years the Pirrie family has outfitted locals and visitors with quality western wear, offering more than 1,500 hats and 2,500 pairs of boots.


Since World War I, when crowds gathered to hear news from the front, Main Street and 1st Street has remained the heartbeat of downtown Kalispell.

Experience touches of the past with modern offerings in this charming setting that is downtown Kalispell.

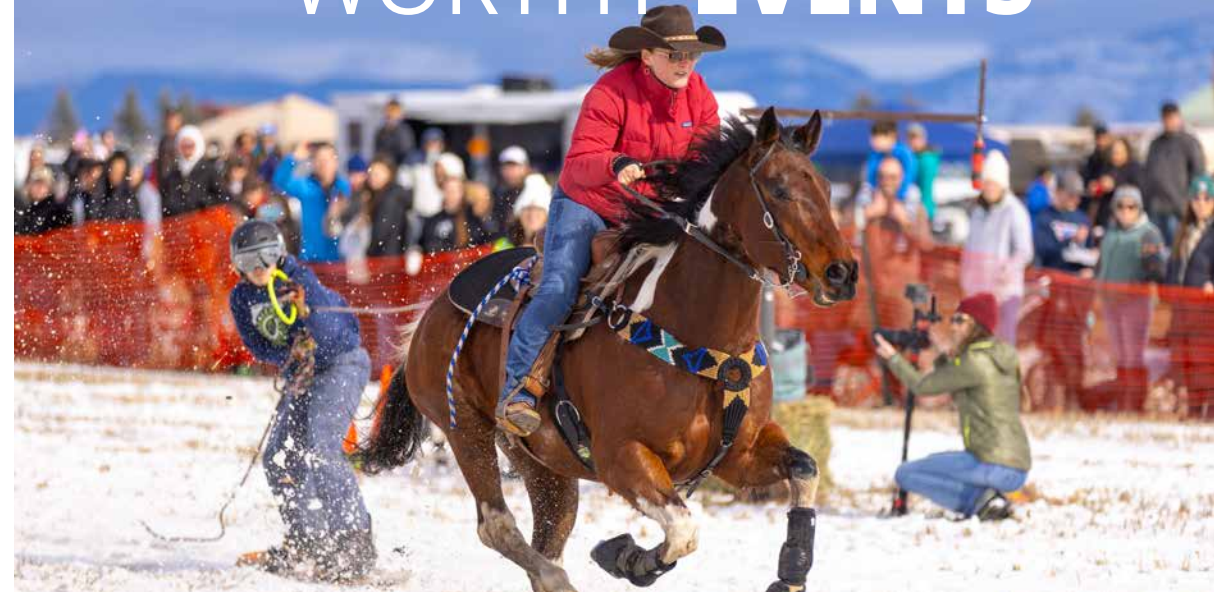

## INDOOR OPTIONS

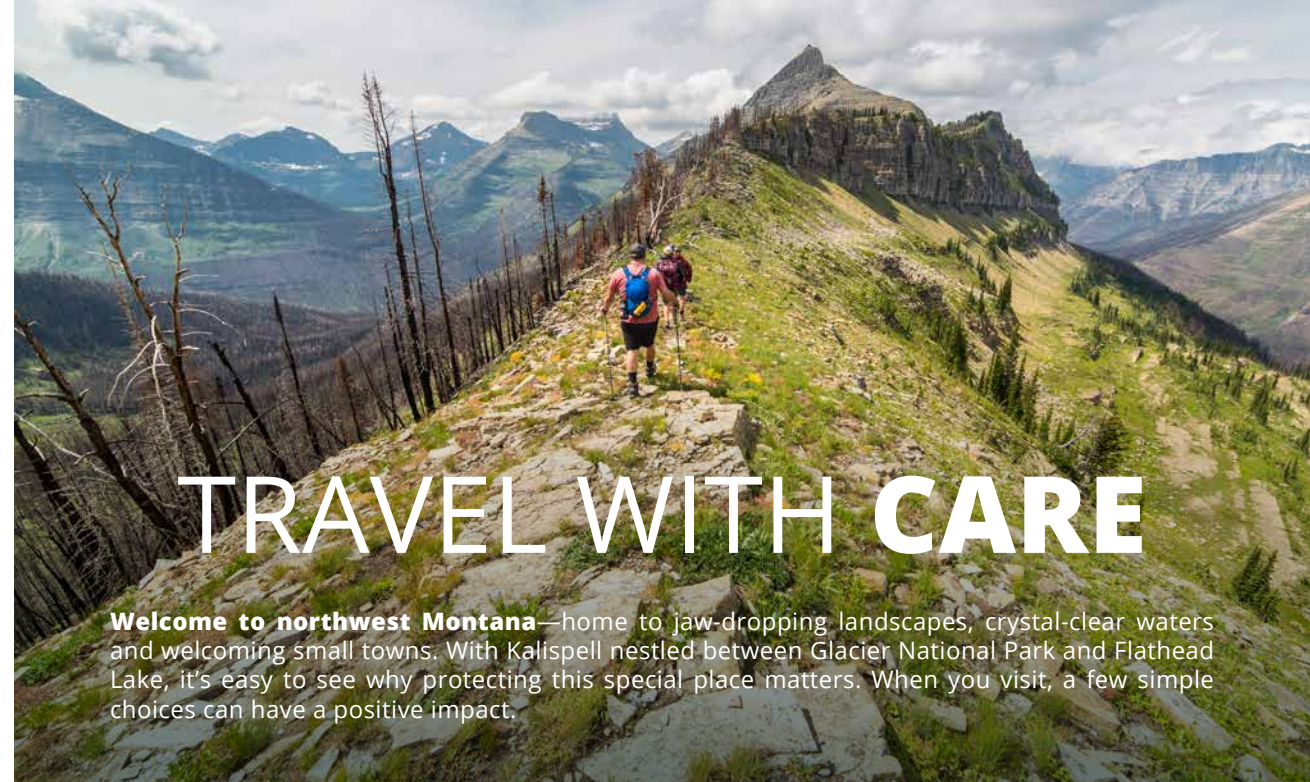

Fire is part of Montana's natural ecosystem, but human-caused fires can have lasting impacts. Use designated fire rings, follow local restrictions and fully extinguish campfires before leaving.



## LET WILDLIFE STAY WILD

Seeing wildlife is unforgettable—just be sure to give animals plenty of space. Hike in groups, carry bear spray and know how to use it and make noise on the trail so wildlife knows you're nearby.

# FLATHEAD LAKE

MILES OF SHORELINE, MILES OF ADVENTURE

Flathead Lake spans more than 200 square miles at the base of the Mission and Swan mountain ranges, with 185 miles of shoreline and some of the clearest freshwater you'll find anywhere. Often called one of Montana's hidden gems, the lake is perfect for exploring at your own pace. Scenic highways circle the shoreline—Highway 35 on the east side and Highway 93 on the west—making it easy to spend a day stopping at local restaurants and shops, swimming spots and seasonal cherry stands along the way.

## BEST SWIMMING SPOTS:

Wayfarers State Park (Bigfork), Somers Beach State Park (North Shore), Volunteer Park (Lakeside).

**Tip:** Many shores are pebbly, water shoes are recommended.

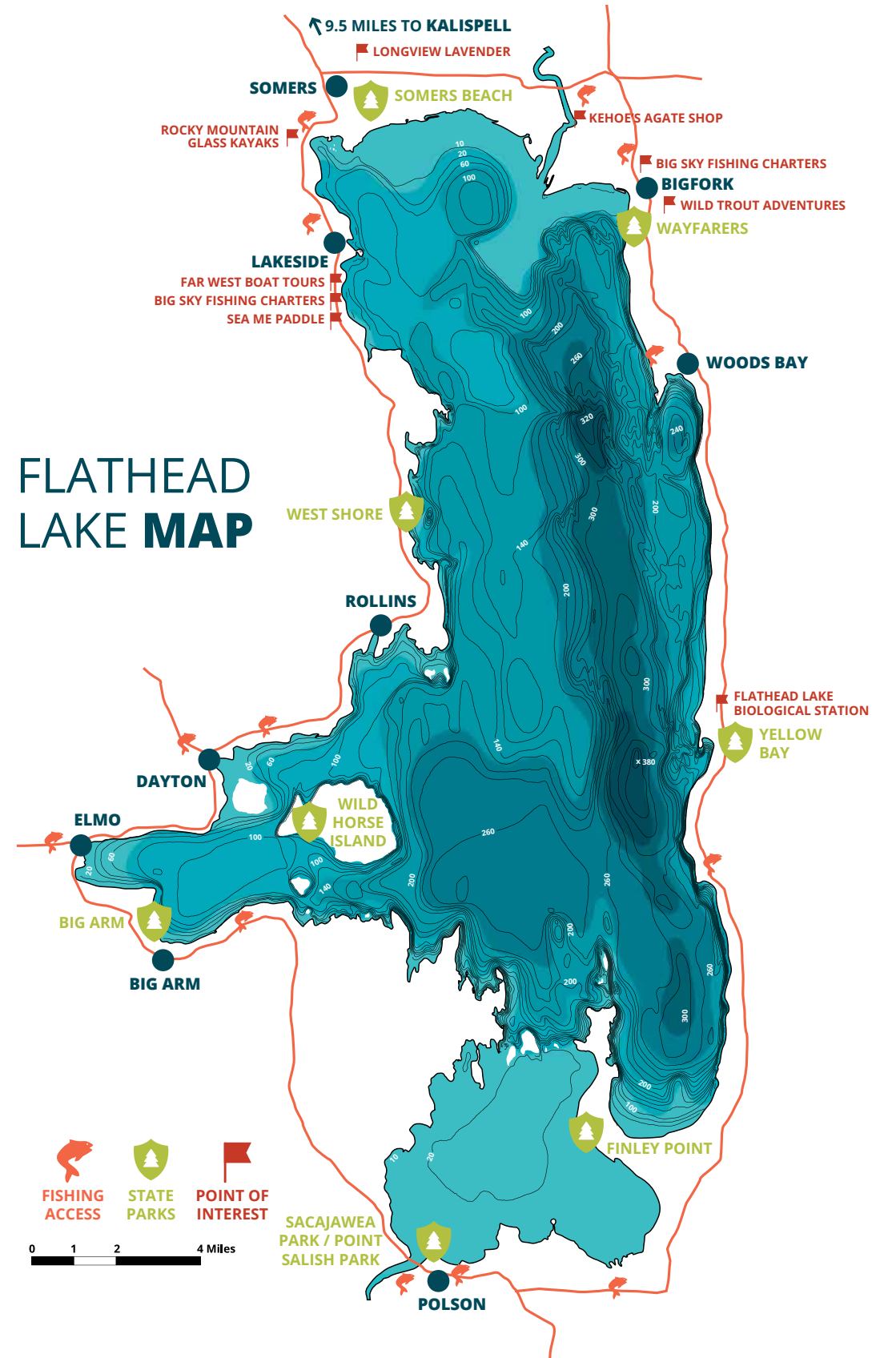

# CROWN OF THE CONTINENT

Encompassing 1 million acres, Glacier National Park is known as the Backbone of the World and leaves an imprint of all who come to visit. Carved by glaciers thousands of years ago, today the park encompasses several ecological areas with a wide variety of macro and micro

habitats, with 71 species of mammals, 276 species of birds, 1,132 species of plants and three species of reptiles. Inside the park's boundaries are the iconic Going-to-the-Sun Road, 734 miles of trails, more than 700 lakes and a handful of glaciers.

From Kalispell, Glacier National Park's west entrance is a scenic 32-mile drive, making it the perfect home base for exploring the park. The west entrance, which is located just past the town of West Glacier, provides direct access to both the Going-to-the-Sun Road and Camas Road, as well as to Apgar Village and Lake McDonald. During the

summer season, the 52-mile-long Going-to-the-Sun Road is open in its entirety (exact dates fluctuate as it's weather dependent), taking travelers through the heart of the park over Logan Pass and out via the park's east entrance in St. Mary. While the entirety of the park is accessible during the summer, it is also the busiest time to visit.



**Autumn** brings colorful fall foliage, pleasant temperatures and prime wildlife-watching opportunities, but with fewer visitors. Going-to-the-Sun Road through the Park is typically open through early October (weather dependent).

**Winter** blankets the landscape with snow and brings the opportunity to snowshoe and cross-country ski. Experience the park with a guide on an excursion with Glacier Institute or Tour Glacier. And if you don't want to venture into the snow, you can always drive to Apgar Village for a picture-perfect sunset view of Lake McDonald or glimpse of the aurora borealis (northern lights).

**Spring** means hikers and bikers have access to the Going-to-the-Sun Road before it opens to vehicle traffic, as well as the opening of lower-elevation trails. Roads to Lake McDonald Lodge or Avalanche Creek on the west side allow for sightseeing. Vehicles can also set out on U.S. Highway 2 along the southern border of the park to access Rising Sun on the east side, depending on snow removal.

# LOCAL'S GUIDE TO TRAILS IN KALISPELL

**A true four-season destination,** Kalispell sits in the lush Flathead Valley and is surrounded by mountain ranges that serve as the perfect backdrop for year-round visits. Here you'll find trails that are ideal for hiking, mountain biking, backpacking, horseback riding and running—just minutes from downtown. Experience trails that are prime for half-day outings or all-day and overnight adventures.

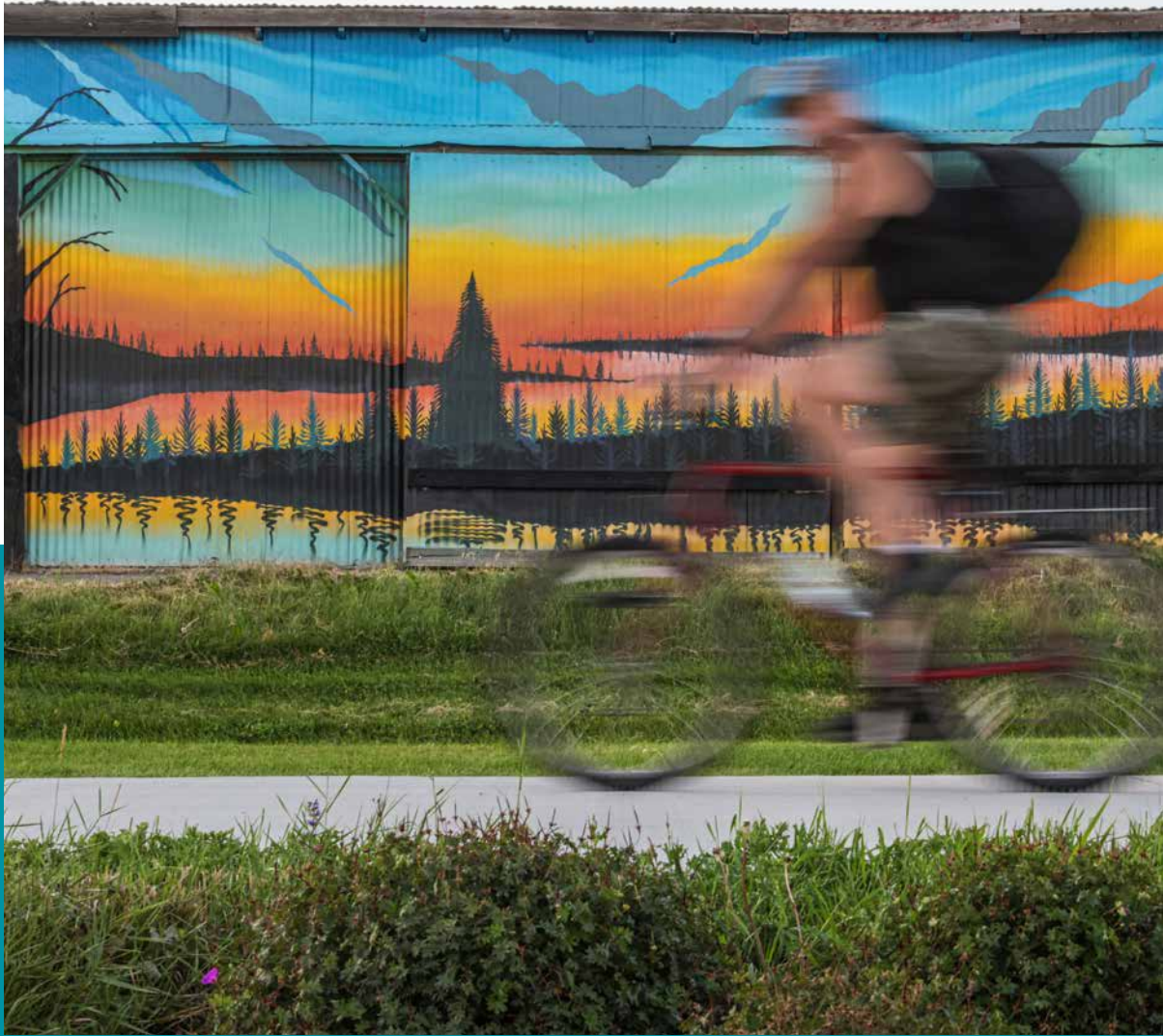

# LARCH MADNESS

While Montana isn't typically high on the list for chasing fall colors, our region may surprise you. The mountains and valleys welcome an array of autumn foliage, with a particular emphasis on golds, yellows and oranges. From the glacial-carved terrain of Glacier National Park to the tree-lined avenues near downtown Kalispell, there are abundant places to soak up the changing colors of autumn.

Tamarack trees, also known as western larch, add a unique golden touch and are exclusive to the northwest spanning from the Cascades in Washington to the Rocky Mountains in Montana and north to British Columbia. Each fall, the needles turn yellow before dropping, showcasing their beauty. Notably, Western Larch, the largest of the larch genus, can grow up to 150 feet tall and live over 700 years. The world's largest recorded larch tree, nicknamed "Gus", stands tall near Seeley Lake, south of Kalispell.

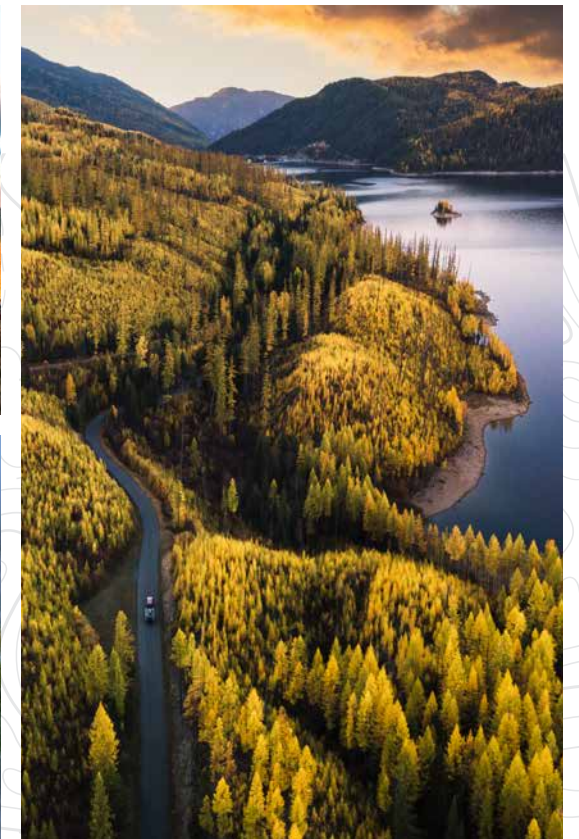
Beyond the trees, autumn offers warm days, cool nights and fewer visitors. Recommended activities for soaking in the array of fall colors include:

# ROAD TRIP TO KALISPELL



## GREAT FALLS, MONTANA

**Route:** I-15 to two-lane highways  
**Time:** 3 hours, 45 minutes

This route offers a scenic and memorable journey. Begin your trip, head north on I-15 until you connect with Highway 89, where you continue traveling north through Browning. Along the way, stop at the Old Trail Museum in Choteau and the Two Medicine Dinosaur Center in Bynum. Reaching Browning, visit the Museum of the Plains Indian before continuing your trip. Between July

and September, travel up Highway 89 to St. Mary's to enter Glacier National Park from the east. From there, take the scenic Going-to-the-Sun Road across to West Glacier. If you travel west on Highway 2, be sure to stop at Marias Pass for breathtaking views into Glacier National Park. Then, continue for another 14 miles to visit Goat Lick Overlook, conveniently located off scenic Highway 2.



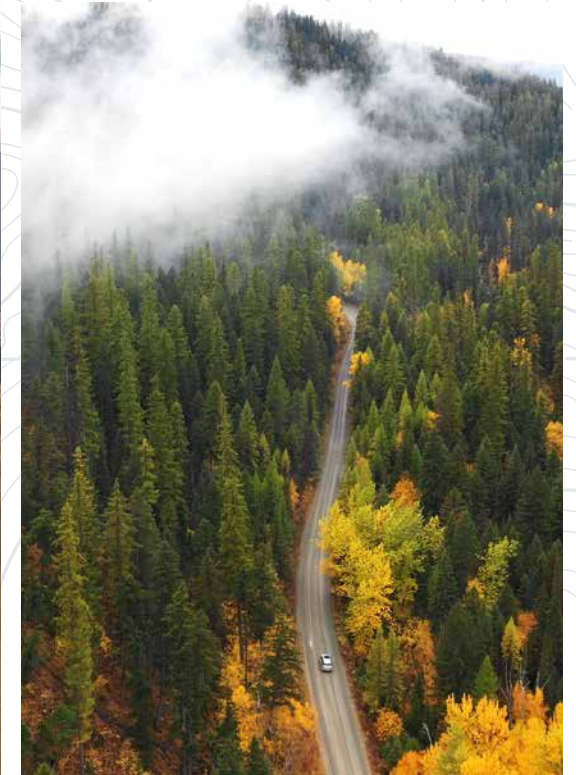

## MISSOULA, MONTANA

**Route:** Two-lane highways  
**Time:** 1 hour, 30 minutes

Start your journey in Missoula and head north on Highway 93. Along the way, make sure to stop at the CSKT Bison Range to see the impressive bison and various wildlife in this expansive reserve. In Charlo, visit the Ninepipes Museum of Early Montana to explore the history of the region's Native American cultures. Continue north to Polson, where you can take Highway 93 up the west shore for stunning views across the lake. Or opt to travel Highway 35 to Bigfork along the east side of the lake with cherry orchards aplenty.



## SPOKANE, WASHINGTON

**Route:** I-90 East to two-lane highways  
**Time:** 4 hours, 26 minutes

Begin your journey by heading east on I-90 toward Coeur d'Alene, then connect with Highway 95. Continue north to Sandpoint, where you can explore the charming downtown area or relax by the lake. In Sandpoint, follow Highway 2 heading east. Be sure to visit the charming town of Troy, which is known for being the lowest elevation in Montana at 1,892 feet above sea level. Next, stop at Kootenai Falls to walk across the Swinging Bridge and experience the stunning waterfalls. Enjoy the scenic route as you pass the Thompson Chain of Lakes along the way to Kalispell.

# DREAM ADAPTIVE RECREATION

## EXPANDING ACCESS TO THE OUTDOORS

In a place like Montana and a community like Kalispell, there is so much to see, do and experience outdoors. But the mountains aren't always designed with accessibility in mind. Enter DREAM Adaptive Recreation.

A local organization, DREAM Adaptive Recreation (DREAM) was founded in 1985 with a mission to **“enhance the quality of life of individuals with disabilities by providing year-round outdoor adaptive recreational opportunities.”** With 40 years under their belts, DREAM is an organization that supports locals and visitors alike in accessing northwest Montana's abundant year-round outdoor recreational opportunities, from downhill skiing and snowboarding to Nordic skiing and biking on trails to enjoying watersports. At the core of it all—a belief that people with disabilities deserve full access to the beauty, opportunity and sense of belonging found throughout northwest Montana. Over the past four decades, DREAM has served many individuals. While reducing barriers to outdoor access is a key goal, DREAM's programs also foster independence, build confidence and instill a sense of belonging in the outdoor community.

Program offerings range from beginner to advanced opportunities, with alpine skiing, cycling and paddling being the most popular programs. A defining feature of DREAM's programs is the opportunity for participants to learn using either standard or adaptive equipment, with teaching techniques designed for each individual and their goals.

As part of this, DREAM works with land managers—including the National Park Service and the U.S. Forest Service—to bring more accessible trails and access points to public lands.

Visitors to Kalispell and northwest Montana can participate in DREAM's program offerings. Advanced registration is required and visitors are encouraged to reach out as early as possible.

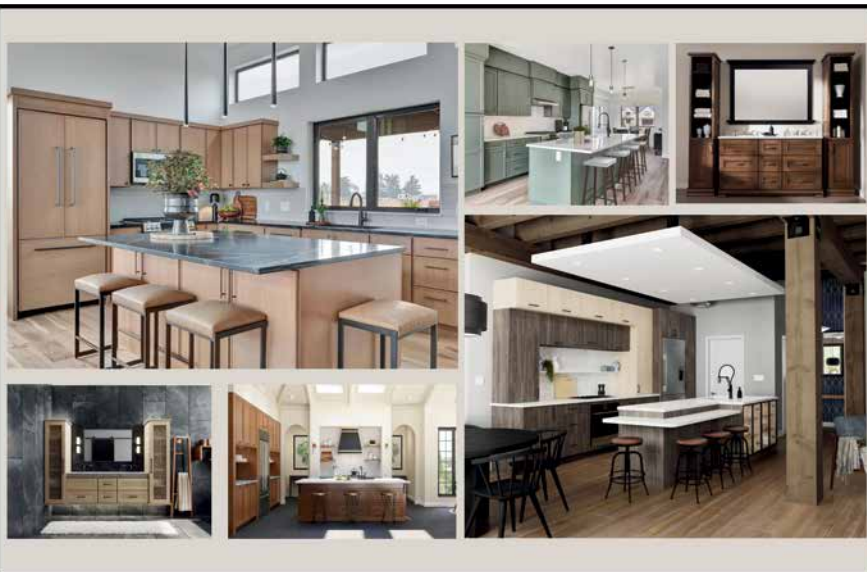

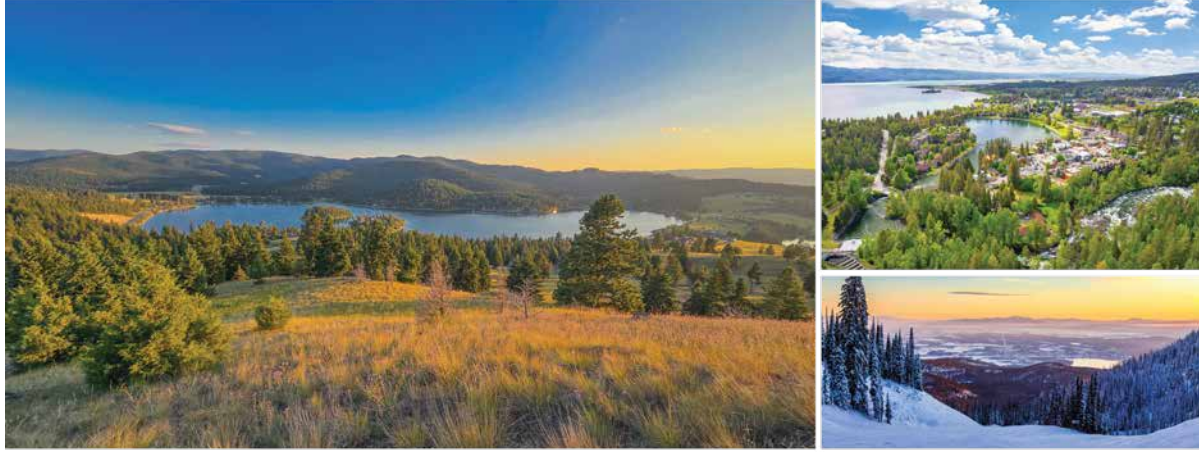

There are several local businesses that provide easy access to that part of Kalispell's story, from vibrant lavender fields to fruit-infused offerings.

**Plant Land** invites you to embrace farm-to-table living with events taking place throughout the year. Enjoy evenings in magical greenhouses with cocktails, canapés and dinners crafted with local ingredients. Year-round workshops provide hands-on experiences in seed starting, hanging basket creation, bonsai sessions and wreath decorating.

**Cherries** grow in orchards along the shore of Flathead Lake, with beautiful cherry blossoms in May and fruit-covered trees in July and August. Take a drive around the lake to see the blossoms in full bloom in the spring. During summer, you can swing by a roadside stand and pick up a bag of freshly picked cherries or try your hand at harvesting them yourself at several U-pick orchards around the lake. You can also find a variety of cherry-assorted items like Flathead cherry lip balm from **Sage & Cedar**.

Don't miss the **Kalispell Farmers Market** every Saturday from May through October. Pick up fresh produce, baked goods, local crafts and native plants.

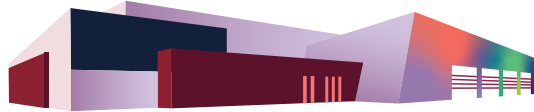

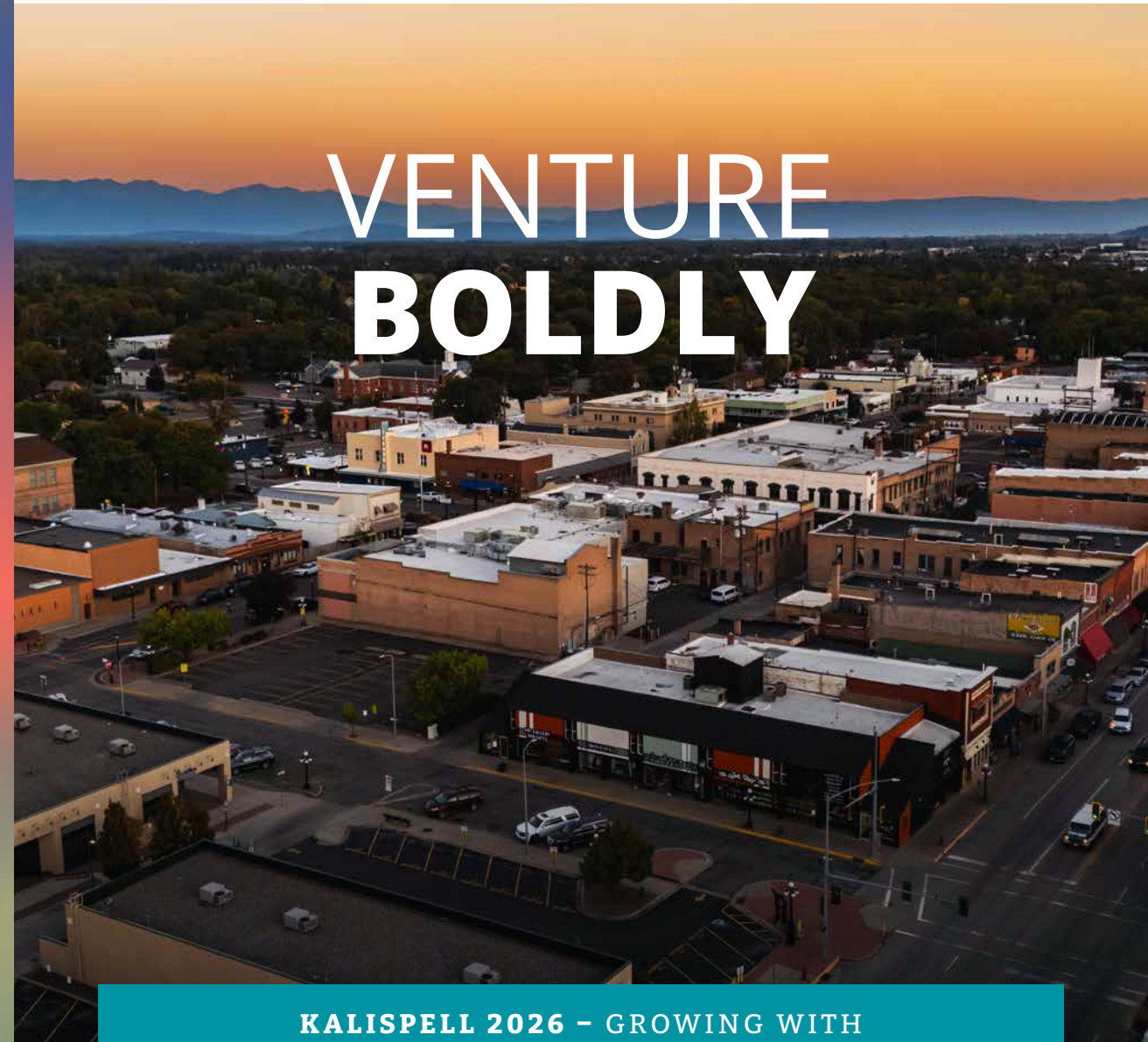

## HEALTHCARE

## ADVANCED MANUFACTURING

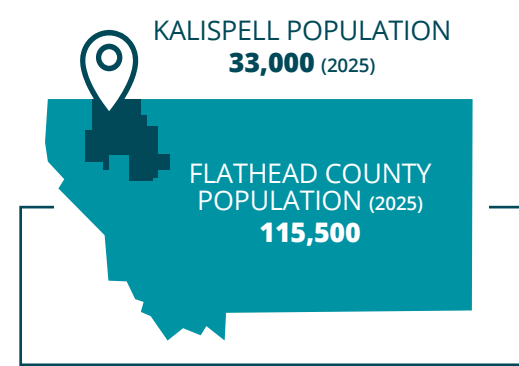

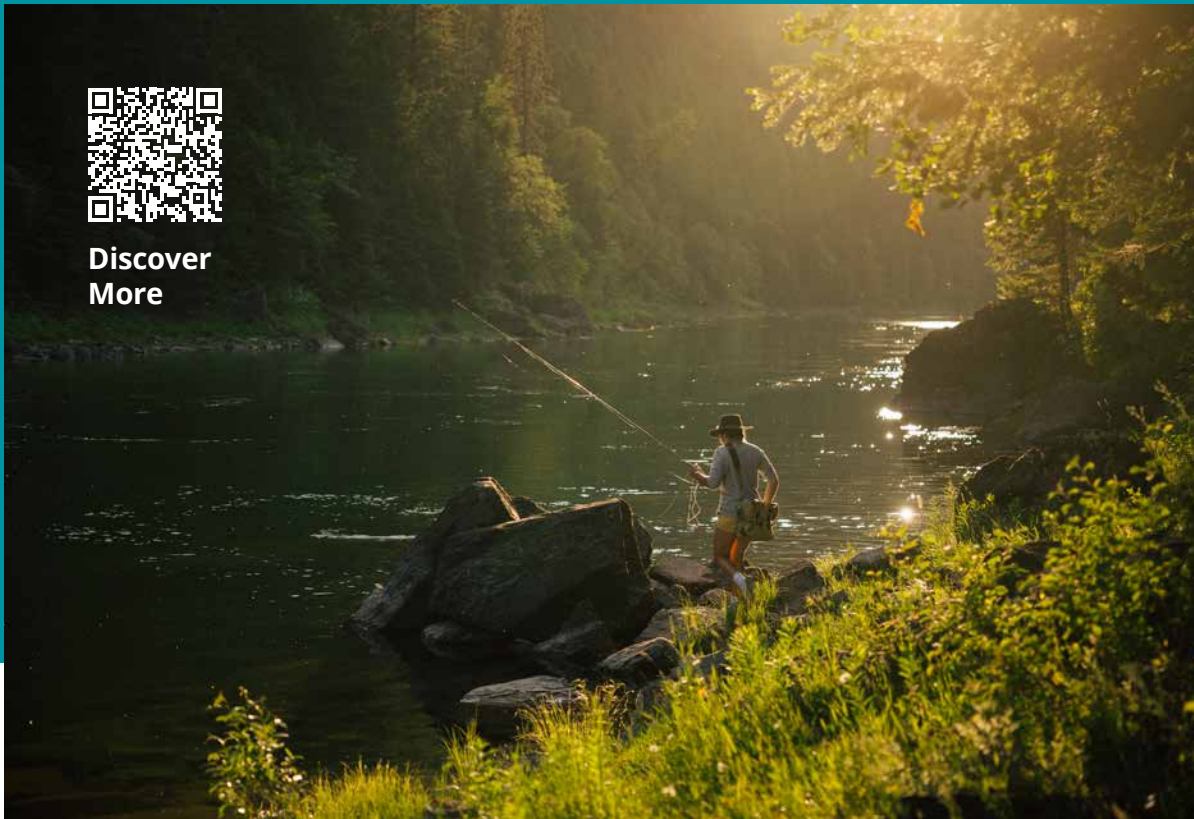

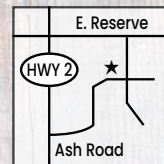
