DEPOT PARK

Downtown Kalispell park with a pavilion and the Flathead Veterans Memorial.

WOODLAND PARK

Roofed picnic areas, playgrounds, walking trails, lagoon with ducks and geese and skate park.

Boulder park, disc golf, large playground and recreational area, walking trails, and roofed picnic area.

HERRON PARK

Hiking, biking, and horseback riding trails, equestrian jumps, horse stalls, dressage arenas. Part of the Foy's To Blacktail Trails.

BIKE & HIKE

RAILS-TO-TRAILS

22+ miles of paved trails throughout the Flathead Valley.

BIKE THE GOING-TO-THE-SUN-ROAD

Bike or walk to Logan Pass before the full length of the Going-To-The-Sun-Road is open to vehicle traffic. Optimal dates are mid-May to mid-June. Visit the parks [Road Status page](#) or call the Apgar Visitor Center at (406) 888-7800 for updates on accessibility. Rent bikes or e-bikes or get a guided tour with [Glacier Guides](#) or [Glacier Outfitters](#).

VISITING THE PARK IN 2026

Here is what you need to know if you are planning to visit:

- No vehicle reservations required.
- Logan Pass parking is limited to three hours.
- Shuttle tickets needed for Going-to-the-Sun Road, available on Recreation.gov. Free tickets have a \$1 processing fee.
- Shuttle ticket booking starts May 2, 2026, for 60 days in advance, and June 30, 2026, for next-day entry.
